

The Banks County Board of Commissioners held a work session/meeting on March 19, 2007 at 4:00 p.m. in the conference room of the Banks County Courthouse with all members present. Attorney Tread Syfan was also present. Chairman Gene Hart called the meeting to order.

**1. Best Health Business License Ordinance Alleged Violation Hearing**

Major Kyle Bryant stated the license was pulled because upon investigation it was found that the business did not have a Georgia state license to operate. He further stated that a background check on applicant/owner Byung Chung did not show any criminal history. He said the license that Mr. Chung had previously furnished was not a Georgia approved license which is required by the state code and local ordinance. He said all employees performing massage or bodywork therapy must be state licensed as well as they must reapply every two years and complete 25 hours of continuing education to recertify. Mr. Chung stated his business was closed at the time the license was pulled and that he currently did not employ a masseuse. Attorney Syfan reiterated that a state license must be furnished by every employee of the business that performs massage or bodywork therapy. Mr. Chung stated he was not aware of this. Comm. Cain made a motion to suspend the license until Mr. Chung employs a Georgia state licensed masseuse. Comm. Barefoot seconded. Two aye votes and motion carried.

**2. TA Operating Corporation to TA Operating, LLC Alcohol License Change**

Ch. Hart stated this was a transfer from TA Operating Corporation to TA Operating, LLC only. A \$300 transfer fee had been paid and it was for operating a package store. Comm. Cain made a motion to approve the transfer. Comm. Barefoot seconded. Two aye votes and motion carried.

**3. Adjournment**

With no further business, Comm. Barefoot made a motion to adjourn. Comm. Cain seconded. Two aye votes and motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:17 p.m.
