The Banks County E-911 Premise Information Form is designed to assist this agency in serving you better in the event of an emergency. The information supplied will be entered into the dispatch database system and will be available to the dispatcher when an emergency 911 call is placed from the residence. It is held as confidential and not released to those not in emergency services and is only used in response to your call for help.

The description of the house is important to help responding units better identify the residence. When describing the house, give as much detail as possible. Make sure to include type of structure and the colors on the structure. (example: Red brick house with white trim, white wood frame, cedar log cabin, white doublewide with black trim, brown singlewide with green trim). Any distinguishable features will assist all of the units in locating your residence.

Having advance knowledge of special needs saves time during a life-threatening emergency. The responding units can better serve the citizens when they are aware of any special equipment or personnel that may be needed to handle the special need.

House numbers should be posted so they are visible from the road from both directions both day and night. If your mailbox is not in front of and on the same side of the street as the residence, it should not be the only place your house number is posted. 911 address numbers should be 3 to 3 ½ inches tall and in reflective material. 911 address numbers and signs can be purchased at the courthouse in Homer to post at the end of your driveway.
